### VI. DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS:

- SYTP – Realignment Subcommittee report out
  - Coral reported out on the progress made on the plan.
  - Met in February to update plan language mostly, no changes to specific content of the plan’s programs or services were made.
  - Voting members have received a scheduling poll and are encouraged to respond to find the best time to meet.
- JJCPA Plan Presentation
  - Megan Gotcher and Sarah Gross presented an overview of the JJCPA plan for FY 26/27.
  - The one notable change is that all funding proposals for JJCPA dollars will be made to the council, and the council will vote on approving funds being distributed to those programs/projects.
- Fortuna Teen Court Funding Request Extension – Raven Majors
  - Request: to Fund Teen Court in its entirety for one year, which would amount to roughly \$120,000. This will allow Raven to continue looking for additional grants.
  - The goal is to consolidate the multiple contracts for multiple programs into one program with multiple locations.
    - Raven also provided a report out on how many cases Teen Court has had recently. A majority are from referring youth to their services.
- Teen Lounge (part of Boys and Girls Club of the Redwoods) is looking for additional funding as well. This includes the Fun, Future, Friendship program.
  - There was discussion between Raven and Coral about bringing forward a couple proposals to the council to be reviewed, that would include funding for one or both teen court locations, and possibly the Teen Lounge as well under a contract for BGCR.
- Direct Referrals to Teen Court – Megan Gotcher
  - Probation has made 9 referrals directly to Teen Court between 9/2025 and 1/2026.
- Natalie Arroyo brought forth First 5’s Positive Parenting Program as a possible funding opportunity should the organization seek to submit a proposal.
- Tina Taylor, Director of Empower, Protect, and Invest.
  - Tina gave a brief overview of her work and the funding request she was bringing forward.
  - EPI is a hotline that receives anywhere from 5- 35 calls per month, and provides first responder services to callers, as well as things like underground railroad beds for trafficking survivors, putting them in hotels, providing transportation, etc.
  - She brought forth information on a human trafficking walk she coordinates annually. The request is for a small amount of funds, about \$3,500, to get the walk going.
  - Tina mentioned she can get a proposal for next meeting.
