### Training Objectives:

- Identify persons at higher risk for TB to determine who should be tested for TB infection
- Describe and apply how to test for TB infection (including the preferential use of interferon gamma release assay [IGRA] testing for non-U.S.-born persons)
- Describe and perform the proper medical evaluation needed to distinguish LTBI from TB disease
- Describe and apply the preferred short-course treatment regimens for LTBI
