



## Measures Primary Election June 2, 2026

This calendar is intended to be a general-purpose resource for those seeking information for the Primary Election on June 2, 2026. We have tried to make it as useful and accurate as possible, but it should not be relied upon in place of the Elections and/or Government Codes for statutory guidance.

<p><b>March 6, 2026 (E-88)</b></p>	<p><b>Deadline to Submit Resolutions of Consolidation</b></p> <p>Last day for the governing body of a district, city, school or other political subdivision to file a request for consolidation with the June 2026 election with the Humboldt County Office of Elections. We encourage jurisdictions planning to have a measure on the ballot to contact the Office of Elections early in the process and review our guide on <a href="#">How to Place a Measure on a Ballot</a>.</p> <p>EC 9109, 9380, 9401, 10002, 10401, 10402, 10403</p>
<p><b>March 7 - March 16 (E-87 to E-78)</b></p>	<p><b>Ten (10) Day Public Inspection Period</b></p> <p>Whenever resolutions calling for a measure to be placed on the ballot are filed, immediately after that filing date there will be a 10-day public inspection period. Documents will be on public display at the Office of Elections, 2426 6th Street, Eureka. During this period, any voter of the jurisdiction or the county elections official may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted.</p> <p>EC 9190, 9380, 9509</p>
<p><b>March 6, 2026 (E-88)</b></p>	<p><b>Deadline for Tax Rate Statement for Bond Measure</b></p> <p>Last day to file tax rate statement for any bond measure appearing on the June ballot. This statement is filed with the Office of Elections.</p> <p>EC9401</p>
<p><b>March 9, 2026 (E-85)</b></p>	<p><b>Measure Letters assigned by Registrar of Voters</b></p> <p>All county, city, or other local measures shall be designated by a letter, instead of a figure, printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of the measure, commencing with the letter "A" and continuing in alphabetical order, one letter for each of these measures appearing on the ballot.</p> <p>EC13116</p>



<p><b>March 16, 2026 (E-78)</b></p>	<p><b>Deadline to Submit an Impartial Analysis</b></p> <p>Deadline for County Counsel to submit impartial analysis for county, school and/or special district measures; City attorney to submit impartial analysis of city measures. County auditor, if previously directed by the board of supervisors, to submit fiscal analysis of measures.</p> <p>EC9160, 9280, 9313, 9500</p>
<p><b>March 16 (E-78)</b></p>	<p><b>Deadline to File Arguments for Measures</b></p> <p>Arguments for or against any measure called for the election are due by 5 p.m. at the Office of Elections. Arguments are public after the deadline. Arguments shall not exceed 300 words.</p> <p>EC 9161-9166, 9281-9287, 9316, 9601</p>
<p><b>March 17 - March 26 (E-77 to E-68)</b></p>	<p><b>Ten (10) Day Public Inspection Period of Measure Arguments</b></p> <p>The county elections official shall make a copy of the materials referred to in Sections 9119, 9120, 9160, 9162, and 9167 available for public examination in the county elections official's office for a period of 10 calendar days immediately following the deadline for submission of those materials.</p> <p>EC9190</p>
<p><b>March 27, 2026 (E-67)</b></p>	<p><b>March 27, 2026 Deadline for Filing Rebuttal to an Argument For or</b></p> <p>Rebuttals to arguments for and against will be due by 5pm at the Office of Elections. Rebuttals are public after the deadline. Rebuttals shall not exceed 250 words.</p> <p>EC9167, 9285, 9317</p>
<p><b>March 28 - April 6 (E-66 to E-57)</b></p>	<p><b>Ten (10) Day Public Examination Period of Rebuttal Arguments</b></p> <p>The county elections official shall make a copy of the materials referred to in Sections 9119, 9120, 9160, 9162, and 9167 available for public examination in the county elections official's office for a period of 10 calendar days immediately following the deadline for submission of those materials.</p> <p>EC9190</p>
