# Free: Test Your Household Items for Lead!



**Bring up to three household items to be tested, while testing supplies last:**

## What we can test:

- Painted items\*
- Dishes, cookware
- Imported items
- Toys
- Antiques

## We cannot test:

- Cosmetics
- Food
- Spices
- Soil
- Water

\*Includes paint chips from pre-1978 home, toys, small painted furniture, etc. Do not scrape paint chips from painted surfaces, this can create lead hazards beyond what already exists.

Lead can be in many household items. Lead can harm a child's brain and make it hard for them to learn, pay attention and behave. Ask your child's doctor for a blood lead test.
