RESOLUTION NO. 76-105

ESTABLISHING THE CENTRAL AVENUE
UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT

WHEREAS, by notice dated June 1, 1976, a public hearing was called for July 20, 1976, at the hour of 1:45 p.m., in the Supervisors' Chambers in the Courthouse, Eureka, California, to ascertain whether the public necessity, health, safety, or welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures, and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, or similar or associated service, within that certain area of the County along Central Avenue, McKinleyville, described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the west right of way line of Central Avenue (County Road No. A4L800), as shown in Relinquishment No. 613 of the State of California to the County of Humboldt, recorded in Book 815 of Official Records, Page 285, Humboldt County Records, that lies S. 1° 00' 16" W. 250 feet from the south right of way line of School Road (County Road No. C3L070) as shown in Book 30 of Deeds, Page 130, Humboldt County Records;

Thence N. 88° 59' 44" W. 250 feet;

Thence N. 1° 00' 16" E. 4760 feet, more or less, to a point lying 20 feet north from the north right of way line of Railroad Drive (County Road No. 4M020), as shown in Book 224 of Deeds, Page 466, Humboldt County Records;

Thence N. 72° 40' 46" E. 474.04 feet;

Thence S. 1° 00' 16" W. 900 feet, more or less, to the south line of that parcel of land conveyed to Roderick H. Cushman, recorded in Book 839 of Official Records, Page 102, Humboldt County Records;

Thence S. 88° 59' 44" E. 150 feet;

Thence S. 1° 00' 16" W. 4030 feet, more or less, to a point which bears S. 88° 59' 44" E. 350 feet from the point of beginning;

Thence N. 88° 59' 44" W. 350 feet to the point of beginning.

Bearings are based on the California Co-ordinate System Zone 1.

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and

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given to all affected property owners as such are shown on the last equalized assessment roll and to all utilities concerned in the manner and within the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held, and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Humboldt that, pursuant to Ordinance No. 652 of the County of Humboldt, the above-described area is hereby declared an underground utility district and is designated as "Central Avenue Underground Utility District." Attached hereto, marked "Exhibit A," and hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution, is a map delineating the boundaries of said District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors does hereby fix March 1, 1978, as the date on which affected property owners must be ready to receive underground service, and does hereby order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, or similar or associated service within the Central Avenue Underground Utility District on or before June 1, 1978;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Clerk is hereby instructed to notify all affected utilities and all persons owning real property within Central Avenue Underground Utility District of the adoption of this resolution within ten (10) days after the

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date of such adoption. Said County Clerk shall further notify said property owners of the necessity that, if they or any person occupying such property desire to continue to receive electric, communication, or other similar or associated service, they or such occupant shall, by the date fixed in this resolution, provide all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive such services from the lines of the supplying utility or utilities at a new location, subject to applicable rules, regulations, and tariffs of the respective utility or utilities on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. Such notification shall be made by mailing a copy of this resolution, together with a copy of said Ordinance No. 652, to all affected property owners as such are shown on the last equalized assessment roll, and to all affected utilities;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors hereby finds and determines as follows:

The Central Avenue Underground Utility District herein created is in the general public interest for the following reasons:

- 1) The undergrounding to be accomplished will avoid or eliminate an unusually heavy concentration of overhead distribution facilities; and
- 2) The streets, roads, or rights of way in the District are extensively used by the general public and carry a heavy volume of pedestrian or vehicular traffic.
