RESOLUTION NO. 83-147

ESTABLISHING KING SALMON
UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1

WHEREAS, by notice dated October 18, 1983, a public hearing was called for November 15, 1983, at 9:00 a.m. in the Supervisors' Chambers in the Courthouse, Eureka, California, to ascertain whether the public necessity, health, safety, or welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures, and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, or similar or associated service, within that certain area of the County at King Salmon described as follows:

BEGINNING at the northwest corner of Lot 16 of Block 6 of the King Salmon Resort Subdivision as recorded in Book 12 of Maps, page 59, Humboldt County Records;
thence along the northerly line of said Lot 16,
S 59° 17' 30" E 20.00 feet;
thence southerly and westerly following parallel to the centerline of Buhne Drive to the south line of Lot 31 of Block 2 of said Subdivision;
thence N 59° 17' 30" W 20.00 feet to the easterly right-of-way line of Buhne Drive;
thence S 15° 42' 30" W along the easterly line of Buhne Drive to its terminus;
thence N 74° 17' 30" W 70.00 feet to a point which lies 20.00 feet west of the westerly right-of-way line of Buhne Drive;
thence northerly and easterly following parallel to the centerline of Buhne Drive to a point which lies N 59° 17' 30" W 90.00 feet from the point of beginning;
thence S 59° 17' 30" E 90.00 feet to the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given to all affected property owners as such are shown on the last equalized assessment

roll and to all utilities concerned in the manner and within the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held, and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Humboldt that, pursuant to Sections 361-1 through 361-15 of the Humboldt County Code, the above-described area is hereby declared an underground utility district and is designated as "King Salmon Underground Utility District No. 1." Attached hereto, marked "Exhibit A," and hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution, is a map delineating the boundaries of said district.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors does hereby fix April 1, 1984, as the date on which affected property owners must be ready to receive underground service, and does hereby order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, or similar or associated service within King Salmon Underground Utility District No. 1 on or before July 1, 1984;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby instructed to notify all affected utilities and all persons owning real property within King Salmon Underground Utility District of the adoption of this resolution within ten (10) days after the date of such adoption. Said Clerk shall further notify

said property owners of the necessity that, if they or any person occupying such property desire to continue to receive electric, communication, or other similar or associated service, they or such occupant shall, by April 1, 1984, provide all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive such services from the lines of the supplying utility or utilities at a new location, subject to applicable rules, regulations, and tariffs of the respective utility or utilities on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. Such notification shall be made by publishing a copy of this resolution once in a newspaper of general circulation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors hereby finds and determines as follows:

The King Salmon Underground Utility District No. 1 herein created is in the general public interest for the following reasons:

1. The street or rights of way are in an area extensively used by the general public and carry a heavy volume of pedestrian or vehicular traffic.
2. The street or rights of way adjoin or pass through a civic area or public recreation area or an area of unusual scenic interest to the general public.
3. Such undergrounding will eliminate an unusually heavy concentration of aerial facilities.

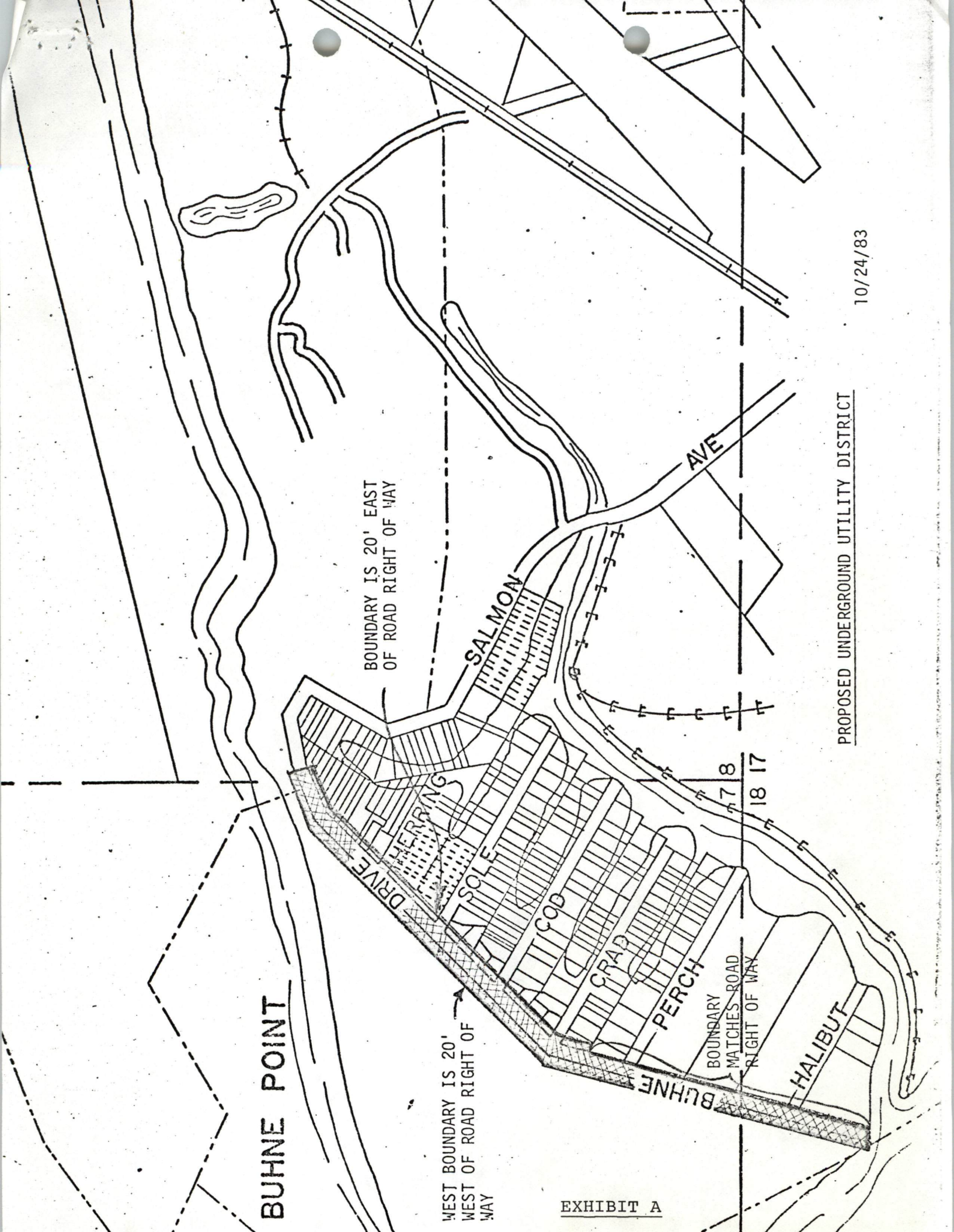
