NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in accordance with the provisions of the Elections Laws of the State of California, that on June 2, 2026, there will be a Statewide Primary Election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that official nomination petitions and declarations of candidacy for eligible candidates desiring to file for the offices listed above are available beginning February 9, 2026 through March 6, 2026, from the Humboldt County Office of Elections at 2426 6th Street, Eureka, CA 95501, Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding holidays. Candidates may obtain more information by calling Humboldt County Office of Elections at 707-445-7481.

The declaration of candidacy must be filed by 5:00 p.m. March 6, 2026, at the Office of Elections.

Declarations of candidacy will not be accepted after 5:00 p.m. on March 6, 2026, unless the incumbent

does not file. If the incumbent does not file, the filing deadline is extended five days to 5:00 p.m. March 11, for anyone other than the incumbent. This extension does not apply to judicial candidates, as they must file declarations of intention earlier and the extension applies at that time.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, per Elections Code § 15101, that the processing of vote-by-mail ballots cast for the Statewide Primary Election will commence on May 5, 2026 or at any time thereafter in the Humboldt County Office of Elections. This process will continue until all election results are tabulated and the election is certified. Any member of the Humboldt County Grand Jury, and any other interested organization, shall be permitted to observe and challenge the manner in which the vote-by-mail ballots are handled, from the processing of ballot return envelopes through the opening, counting and disposition of the ballots. To register as an observer, please contact the Humboldt County Office of Elections at 707-445-7481.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, pursuant to Elections Code §12109, that at the Statewide Primary Election, voted ballots will be counted at each voting location and at the central count at the Humboldt County Office of Elections. All ballots will be tallied at the Humboldt County Office of Elections, 2426 6th Street, Eureka, after the polls have closed on Election Day.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, pursuant to Elections Code §15301, that the canvass will commence at 9:00 a.m. on June 4, 2026 at the Humboldt County Office of Elections. The Office of Elections will begin a manual tally of one percent of cast ballots at the June 2, 2026, Statewide Primary Election. This manual tally is open to the public and shall continue daily (Saturdays, Sundays and holidays excluded unless otherwise decided by the County Registrar of Voters) until completed.
