On June 7th, 2015, at approximately 0225 hours, while off duty in his personal vehicle Anthony Lagarda got into a solo vehicle accident on North Bank Road and Hunts Road. Lagarda's vehicle was disabled and he fled the scene of the accident on foot. CHP was notified of the accident by a passing motorist. During the course of the investigation, CHP contacted Lagarda at his residence, [REDACTED] at approximately 0330 hours. Lagarda advised that he had been drinking alcohol at the Blue Lake Casino and he drove home. He then reported that someone must have stolen his vehicle because it was gone out of his driveway, Lagarda denied being in an accident. Lagarda then signed a CHP 180 under penalty of perjury. On June 8th, 2015, Lagarda contacted the CHP and advised that he lied about reporting his vehicle stolen. He admitted after a night of drinking at the Blue Lake Casino, to crashing his vehicle on Northbank Road and then fleeing the scene of the accident. He also admitted to fraudulently reporting his vehicle stolen. On July 1, 2015, A. Lagarda was placed on Admin Leave for an incident that occurred. On September 1st, 2015, the day he was ordered to come in and give a statement to an Internal Affairs investigator, he submitted his resignation for "medical reasons." Attached you will find the plea agreement that shows Lagarda pled guilty to "wet" reckless, CVC 23103, and for filing a false police report 148.5 PC. He is on probation for 3 years. He is unable to a police officer any more, due to the fact he filed a false police report. We have signed memorandums from Lagarda regarding the details of this case and an internal affairs investigation for any necessary documentation.


- 20. I have read and understood the above charts which list the minimum and maximum penalties for the offense(s) I am charged with. (See item No. 34 for the offenses not listed in the charts.) . . .
- 21. I understand that in addition to the fine, the Court will add assessments which will significantly increase the amount I must pay. I will also be ordered to make restitution and to pay a restitution fine of \$100 to \$1,000 unless the Court finds compelling and extraordinary reasons not to do so. . .
- 22. I understand that if I was under the age of 21 at the time of my arrest, my driver's license will also be suspended for 1 year, and I must surrender my license to the Court.
- 23. I understand that if my blood-alcohol level was .15 percent or above, or if I refused to submit to a chemical test, the Court will consider this in determining whether to enhance the penalties, grant probation, or impose additional terms of probation.


25. I understand that the Court may order my vehicle impounded at my expense for up to 30 days. It may also require me to install an ignition interlock device (IID) for up to three years. Installation of this device, which prevents the vehicle from starting if I have alcohol in my body, does not authorize me to drive without a valid license.
26. I understand that if the Court determines that I would present a traffic safety or public safety risk if I am authorized to drive during the license suspension period, I will be unable to obtain a restricted driver's license from the DMV, which would allow me to drive to and from work, and to and from the alcohol/drug treatment program.
27. I understand that the DMV may suspend my driver's license under a civil procedure which is separate from this criminal action. I understand that the DMV's action, if any, will be in addition to the Court's sentence and that I must obey it.
28. I understand that the DMV will prohibit me from operating a **commercial** vehicle for one year if I am convicted of a first DUI violation, or willfully refused to submit to or complete a chemical test to determine my blood-alcohol level, which occurred in any vehicle.
29. I understand that the DMV will revoke my driver's license for a period of 4 years if I have a prior felony conviction in the past 10 years of Vehicle Code § 23152 or 23153 or Penal Code § 192(c)(1), or any conviction within 10 years of Penal Code § 191.5(a), 191.5(b), or 192.5(a).
30. I understand that proof of my successful completion of an alcohol/drug program must be received at DMV headquarters in order for me to have my driving privilege reinstated, even if I am not ordered to attend such a program by the Court. I also understand that I must surrender my license to the Court.
31. I understand that the DMV will not restore my driving privilege following a driver's license suspension unless I provide the DMV with proof of insurance for 3 years.
32. I understand that the DMV may consider any of my other convictions for DUI or reckless driving, even those that are not charged in this proceeding, and may impose a more severe driver's license suspension, or revocation as a result.
33. I understand that if I am not a citizen, a plea of guilty or no contest (*nolo contendere*) could result in my deportation, exclusion from admission to this country, or denial of naturalization.
34. I understand that a plea of no contest will have exactly the same effect in this case as a plea of guilty, but it cannot be used against me in a civil lawsuit.

8 **SUMMARY:**

9 On June 07, 2015, at approximately 0242 hours, I was on patrol in a fully marked CHP patrol
10 vehicle (8353), in full tan CHP uniform, with my partner Officer J. Esselman (#20946), the driver,
11 in the County of Humboldt. At this time, I was responding to a call of a traffic collision, with a
12 pick-up truck facing the wrong direction on SR-200 (North Bank Road), at Azalea Avenue. I
13 responded from US-101 northbound, north of Eureka and arrived at the scene of the traffic
14 collision at approximately 0248 hours. Upon my arrival, I contacted Humboldt Communications
15 Center (HCC) and informed them the correct location for the traffic collision was SR-200, west of
16 Hunts Road. I observed a [REDACTED] partially on the north shoulder, resting
17 on the ascending dirt embankment, facing the wrong direction. I looked in the cab of the [REDACTED]

33 (AL) Hunts Road was just east of the incident.

34

35 (SN) This is a hand drawn diagram, nothing to scale by any means, State Route 200, you have the
36 eastbound lane and the westbound lane and here is Hunts Road. Can you show me, even draw
37 (requested a black pen from Marvin Kirkpatrick). Can you show me your driving action, what happen,



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- 1 does that make since? I went out there this morning, there is debris on this side of the road (Hunts
- 2 Road) and debris on this side of the road (Hunts Road).
- 3
- 4 (AL) Then I can't give you a specific, like I said, I can't tell you exactly, I can't tell you how the car,
- 5 what side of the car hit, what kind of literally, because just the initial contact just surprised me so much,
- 6 I don't even know what it did, I don't recall.
- 7
- 8 (SN) After the accident, you got out, did you hang around your vehicle for a little bit, or did you start
- 9 walking?
- 10
- 11 (AL) I am sure there were a few "oh fucks" going on in there, so, I mean...
- 12
- 13 (SN) Did you call anybody to pick you up?
- 14
- 15 (AL) No.
- 16
- 17 (SN) How long do you think it took you to walk to, from where the accident happened to get home?
- 18
- 19 (AL) Could not say for sure.
- 20
- 21 (SN) When you got home, was there a television on or a radio on that has a program that you might
- 22 recall would give an approximate time?
- 23
- 24 (AL) No.
- 25
- 26 (SN) Anybody stop to see if you were okay, or offer you a ride?
- 27
- 28 (AL) No.
- 29
- 30 (SN) You walked, just walked the road to [REDACTED] you walked over the hill of [REDACTED] and
- 31 [REDACTED] to...
- 32
- 33 (AL) [REDACTED] to [REDACTED]
- 34
- 35 (SN) [REDACTED] Nobody picked you up and you never called anybody.
- 36
- 37 (AL) No.

Discovery
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1 (SN) So the officers, you get home, what kind of time frame from the time you get home and the officers
2 knock on your door?

3
4 (AL) 20 to 30 minutes. [mumble] but I don't know. I mean I had quite a bit of adrenalin.

5
6 (SN) Once you got home for the approximate 30 minutes before the officers knocked on the door, can
7 you tell me again what events took place? What did you do at home before the officers knocked on the
8 door?

9
10 (AL) I sat down in my office, I was confused, I got a beer when I got there, some tequila, I had a beer
11 and a couple tequilas. I was just confused. Like I said, I have no logical explanation for my actions and
12 decisions.

13
14 (SN) You were in your office when the officers knocked on the door?

15
16 (AL) No, I was in bed already. So then after that I went to lay down in bed and a short time after that is
17 when they knocked on the door. I took out my contacts.

18
19 (SN) Were you injured during the time of this accident at all?

20
21 (AL) Soreness in my neck and chest.

22
23 (SN) Do you have abrasions on your neck and shoulders? Can we take a look right there? (Mr. Lagarda
24 unbuttoned his shirt and exposed his neck and shoulders. No abrasions noticed).

25
26 (AL) They looked that day to, they checked.

27
28 (SN) How about the other side?

29
30 (AL) I had my seatbelt on.

31
32 (SN) Very good.

33
34 (AL) I don't think I would be here right?

35
36 (SN) Could possibly be. So you answered the door, there were two officers there, what conversations
37 took place?

38



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1 (AL) It's difficult to say, there is so much going through my head that it's hard to [mumble].

2
3 (SN) Did they ask you about your vehicle being involved in an accident? Do you recall what you told
4 them?

5
6 (AL) That I was unaware of it.

7
8 (SN) They asked you where your vehicle currently was at the time, do you recall what you told them?

9
10 (AL) I told them it was in the driveway, I told them I was unaware of the incident.

11
12 (SN) And then they brought to your attention that your vehicle was not in the roadway, I mean in your
13 driveway?

14
15 (AL) {pause, no answer}.

16
17 (SN) What did they ask, or what did you tell them?

18
19 (AL) You know I mean they got an accurate report of what occurred, I think they documented their
20 incident pretty well, at this point I don't feel comfortable giving specific recollection of everything that
21 occurred, given the fact I think they got a, that they took documentation of the conversations that
22 occurred. I think I am forth coming with the fact that you know what I didn't make poor choices, I
23 wasn't genuine in my comments of the recollection of my comments and that why I am here and doing
24 so now.

25
26 (SN) We appreciate that. One of the officers filled out a CHP 180, it was brought to their attention that
27 your vehicle was stolen from the driveway and they filled this information out, this happens to be a
28 stolen report. The officers advised you of the penalty of perjury of reporting your vehicle stolen, and
29 you signed the report. Is that your signature right there?

30
31 (AL) That is my signature, I don't recall them using the term perjury but what I understand what I was
32 acknowledging, I understand that I was acknowledging the statements that I made to them, but I don't
33 understand why I made those statements, but yes I understand.

34
35 (SN) Have you ever filled out one of these reports yourself?

36
37 (AL) Yes.

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1 (SN) And when you take a stolen vehicle report, or any stolen report whatsoever, there is a statement on
2 here that reads "I certify or declare under the penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California
3 that the foregoing is true and correct". You are familiar with this on the CHP180 that you had other
4 people sign before and I fact you signed this one?
5

6 (AL) Not the specific wording, but I can't say I am familiar with the concept of stolen vehicle reports
7 that the person is signing saying that they are acknowledging what they are saying is true. Like I said, I
8 don't think I was making, [mumble] going through a good thought process.
9

10 (SN) There is a lot of confusion with incidents like that.
11

12 (AL) In hindsight I don't feel like I was in a state to be making a sworn statement of any kind.
13

14 (SN) That is due because of the stress you are under, the adrenal in you are under, the medication that
15 you are under?
16

17 (AL) The alcohol I had been drinking.
18

19 (SN) Do you recall how many beers you had at the casino?
20

21 (AL) I recall 3, that's the best of my recollection. I had some tequila when I came home. I am
22 remembering ordering one at the table and when it came I really did not need one and I gave it to
23 somebody else who was sitting there.
24

25 (TM) You were involved in the crash trying to avoid a deer and wrecked your truck, why would you
26 leave the scene and go home and not call us to help you out, get a tow truck and take a crash report.
27

28 (AL) I have no logical explanation why I did what I did. That is what's disturbing to me. That's why
29 it's so difficult for me to put the pieces and how I actually come in and clarify, it was a matter of should
30 I or shouldn't I, how do I even just, how do I do this, it's something that's taken, I have, excuse me
31 ma'am, I have no logical explanation.
32

33 (SN) How did the officers act, how did they treat you while talking at the residence?
34

35 (AL) They treated me like a suspect. They did not believe what I was saying. There was probably a
36 response on my part of you know being a little snappy with them a couple of times, and they were in
37 return. One in particular, and I regret that.
38

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- 1 (TM) Did you, were you wearing the same clothes you were wearing when they contacted you?
2
3 (AL) I was in my robe.
4
5 (TM) So did you change...
6
7 (AL) I already, I took out my contacts, changed in, got in bed. I answered the door I did not have my
8 glasses on.
9
10 (TM) Who was home with you?
11
12 (AL) My wife and son.
13
14 (SN) How old is your son?
15
16 (AL) [REDACTED] he was asleep and never woke up.
17
18 (SN) Does your wife know about the incident?
19
20 (AL) Yes.
21
22 (SN) Does she know what you are here to tell us today, or does she only know the incident as you told
23 the officers?
24
25 (AL) She knows of the incident as I told the officers, and what I am here to tell you today.
26
27 (SN) Okay, get it off of your chest and it will make you feel better. It will relieve a lot of stress for you.
28
29 (SN) (referring to Tami McCanless and Marvin Kirkpatrick) Do you have any other questions?
30
31 (MK) Tony, when the officers showed up did you know they were officers?
32
33 (AL) They identified themselves as CHP.
34
35 (MK) And you recognized them at that point?
36
37 (AL) Yes.
38



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1 (SN) Have you called your insurance company yet?

2

3 (AL) No.

4

5 (SN) (question for Tami McCanless) Did the officers get the insurance info?

6

7 (TM) I am not sure. I do not believe so. Do you have information with you for insurance?

8

9 (AL) Not with me, no.

10

11 (MK) Who do you have insurance with?

12

13 (AL) [REDACTED]

14

15 (SN) Do you know who your claims adjust here, or your agent?

16

17 (AL) No, I just call Colorado I think.

18

19 (SN) You do not have anybody local?

20

21 (AL) No. I did not want a scenario of lying. I am not a dishonest person, while I have obviously not
22 been honest here, previously, I am here now. I made some mistakes in my life. Never had to own up to
23 anything like this before. I am ashamed. I apologies to you and your colleagues, and mine and yours
24 (referring to the District Attorney's office). And its, in the end I was not going to take it, I was not got
25 the avenue where I was going to fill my life with lies forever indefinitely, I mean it's one that, sorry, I
26 am here today trying to do the best think that I could in a very bad situation.

27

28 (SN) We appreciate your honesty and for you coming in and doing so. Is there anything else that you
29 may want to add or maybe something you expected us to ask, or something you want to clarify?

30

31 (AL) What happens from here?

32

33 (SN) On the standpoint of the Highway Patrol, they will be doing an your investigation, they will be
34 writing up the accident itself, they will be writing up the incident that occurred throughout the evening,
35 they will submit it to the District Attorney's office, the District Attorney's office decides what they want
36 to do with it.

3 **NOTIFICATION:**

4 On 06/07/2015, at approximately 0242 hours, I was dispatched to a call of a traffic collision with a

19 Vehicle #1 overturned and collided with the asphalt roadway and shoulder (AOI #2). After the

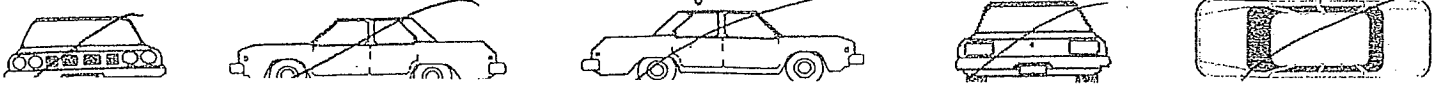



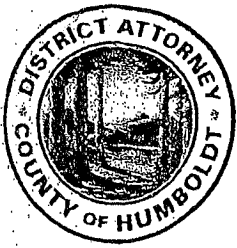

NARRATIVE / SUMMARY

On 6-7-15 at about 1249 hours, while off-duty I received a message on my phone from HCSO Deputy Sheriff Anthony "Tony" Lagarda. I did not notice the message until about 1335 hours. The message was short, Lagarda asked me to call him at his residence and that it was urgent. I returned the call on the above date at 1340 hours and spoke with Deputy Lagarda.

NOTE: I am a Sheriff Lieutenant assigned as the North Area Commander and responsible for all Sheriff's operations north of Arcata. Deputy Lagarda worked the North Area as a patrol deputy.

The following is summary of what I recall from our conversation:

Lagarda started by telling me his truck was stolen the night before and found "totaled" on North Bank Road. He told me he was contacted at his residence by CHP and that is when he discovered his truck stolen. Lagarda asked me if this situation was something that required official notification of law enforcement contact as outlined in HCSO policy. We discussed that for a moment and I sympathized with his situation. Lagarda then added that he had been at the casino earlier in the evening but he didn't specify which casino. I assumed the Blue Lake Casino because I know he frequents that casino. He admitted to drinking alcohol while at the casino but said it was not excessive. He told me he later drove home. At his house he told me he consumed more alcohol including at least one "shot". I do not recall Lagarda specifying exactly what type of alcohol the "shot" was nor exactly how many drinks he had. He said he arrived home around 0130 hours, had some drinks and went to bed. He was awoken about one and half hours later by a CHP Officer at his front door, who questioned him about his vehicle found on North Bank Road. He told me the CHP Officer questioned him about his level of intoxication. Afterwards, the officer was not overly concerned about his sobriety and completed a stolen vehicle report. Lagarda reiterated he did not believe the CHP was investigating this incident with him as a suspect. That ended our conversation on that date.

On the same date, a short time later I was contacted by Undersheriff Honsal who informed me he had been contacted by CHP who informed him of their investigation. I told Undersheriff Honsal I had been contacted by Deputy Lagarda and we compared what was told to us by Lagarda and CHP. I quickly realized Lagarda's recollection of events, as told to me, was very different from that of CHP's.

The next day, 6-8-15, I was on-duty. At about 1227 hours, I received a message from Lagarda asking if I would be available to meet with him. Lagarda asked me if we could meet at his residence, as he was off-duty and wanted privacy. I declined to meet with him at his residence but we did meet in private at the Sheriff's Animal Shelter at about 1335 hours. When I arrived at the shelter I met with Lagarda in the parking lot and we went

inside to a private office. To me Lagarda's demeanor was quiet and distressed. He appeared stressed and emotional. He sat down in a chair and looked away from me blankly at the wall. Before he spoke I told him that he needed to understand that I did not consider our conversation to be confidential or private and that I was willing to listen to whatever he had to say.

NOTE: At no time during our conversation did I ask Lagarda any questions. I allowed him to speak freely and listened. This conversation was not audio recorded as I did not have a recording device.

The following is what I recall from the conversation we had at the shelter:

Lagarda sat with a blank stare on his face for several seconds and did not say anything. He then became emotional, crying, and told me that he had lied on Sunday. He told me that lying is not who he is and that he needed to tell what really happened. Lagarda admitted to drinking at the casino but said that he still didn't think he was too intoxicated to drive and had even turned down a "shot" at the casino and gave it to another person anticipating that he was driving home. After he left the casino he was driving on North Bank Road and a deer ran out in front of him at Huntz Drive which he swerved to miss causing him to drive off the roadway. He was scared and walked home, which he said was "stupid". When he arrived home he had some more drinks and was later contacted by CHP. Lagarda admitted that he had lied to the CHP officer. He said that he planned to contact CHP next to give them a new statement.

Lagarda was emotional and appeared very remorseful

After our conversation at the shelter Lagarda drove to the Arcata CHP Office and I followed. I departed the CHP office as Lagarda was going inside to speak with investigators. I did not take part in the interviews at the CHP office.
