

**NOTICE OF ELECTION AND
NOTICE OF DATE FIXED FOR SUBMISSION OF ARGUMENTS**

**South Bay Union School District
Measure D**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the qualified electors of the South Bay Union School District that an election shall be held on November 3, 2020, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the South Bay Union School District the following measure:

“To improve South Bay and Pine Hill Schools; repair/replace leaky roofs; modernize/construct classrooms, restrooms and school facilities; and make health and safety improvements; shall South Bay Union School District’s measure be adopted authorizing \$5,000,000 of bonds at legal interest rates, raising on average \$312,000 annually as long as bonds are outstanding at a rate of 3 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation, have independent citizens’ oversight and NO money used for administrative salaries and all money staying local?”

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that written arguments shall be submitted to the Humboldt County Office of Elections no later than 5:00 pm on August 14, 2020, until which time arguments may be changed or withdrawn by the proponents until and including the date fixed for filing arguments. The Humboldt County Office of Elections is located at 2426 6th Street, in Eureka, California.

The governing board or any member or members of the board authorized by the board or any individual voter who is eligible to vote on the measure or bona fide association of citizens or any combination of such voters and associations may file written arguments for or against the measure.

No arguments submitted will be accepted unless accompanied by the name(s) of the person(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization and the name of at least one of its principal officers.

No arguments shall exceed 300 words in length. Arguments submitted shall be entitled either “**Argument in Favor of Measure D**” or “**Argument Against Measure D.**”

If more than one argument for “Measure D” or more than one argument against “Measure D” is submitted to the Office of Elections within the time prescribed, the clerk shall select one argument in favor of the measure and one argument against the measure for printing and distribution to the voters of Measure D.
