### November 2, 2021 (306) UNIFORM DISTRICT ELECTION

**NOTE:** Code sections provided are not exhaustive, but rather intended to add understanding and guidance for completing tasks.

<b>Aug 6</b>	<p><b>Last Day to Submit Resolutions of Consolidation</b> Last day for the governing body of a district, city, school or other political subdivision to file a request for consolidation of a local election for measures with UDEL election with the Humboldt County Office of Elections. The elections office will prepare an agenda item to bring consolidations before the Board of Supervisors for approval.</p> <p>Whenever resolutions calling for a measure to be placed on the ballot are filed, immediately after that filing date there will be a 10-day public inspection period. Documents will be on public display at the Humboldt County Office of Elections, 2426 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Eureka. During this period, any voter of the jurisdiction or the county elections official may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Sections 9190, 9380, 10401, 10402, 10403</p>
<b>Aug 6</b>	<p><b>Deadline for Filing Tax Rate Statement for Bond Measures</b> Last day to file tax rate statement for any bond measure appearing on the November ballot. This statement is filed with the Office of Elections.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Section 9401</p>
<b>Aug 11</b>	<p><b>Amendment or Withdrawal of Measure Deadline</b> Last day for county elections official to receive a resolution from a legislative body requesting to withdraw or amend a measure previously submitted for placement on the ballot.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Section 9605</p>
<b>Aug 13</b>	<p><b>Deadline to File Measure Arguments</b> Arguments for or against any measure called for the November 2019 election are due by 5PM at the Humboldt County Office of Elections, 2426 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Eureka. Arguments are made public after the 5PM deadline.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Sections 9163, 9316 Government Code, Section 6061</p>
<b>Aug 14 - Aug 23</b>	<p><b>10 Day Public Inspection of Measure Arguments</b> 10-day public inspection of arguments filed by August 21. During the 10-calendar-day examination period provided by this section, any</p>

	<p>voter of the jurisdiction in which the election is being held, or the county elections official, may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all materials to be amended or deleted. The writ of mandate or the injunction request shall be filed no later than the end of the 10-day period.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Section 9190</p>
<b>Aug 21</b>	<p><b>Measure Proofs</b>  By this date, proponents of measures shall have notified the elections office of any discrepancies in materials that are to be published in the county VIG.</p>
<b>Aug 23</b>	<p><b>Deadline for Filing Rebuttals and Analyses to Measures</b>  Rebuttals to arguments for and against will be due by 5 pm. Rebuttals shall not exceed 250 words.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Sections 9167, 9317</p> <p>County counsel to submit analysis for county and school/special district measures; City Attorney to submit analysis of city measures.  <p style="text-align: right;">Sections 9160, 9313, 9280</p> <p>County auditor, if previously directed by the Board of Supervisors, to submit fiscal analysis of measures.  <p style="text-align: right;">Section 9160</p> <p>Rebuttals and analyses are made public after 5 pm.</p> </p></p>
